Communication and language

We will talk about ourselves and our families and share photographs and belongings from home on the 13th of September.

We will hopefully have a baby come to visit our class on the 23rd of September to discuss how we have changed.

We will learn about owls; we will have first-hand experience with owls when they visit our school on 7th of October.

We will learn about how we are all different and why we should celebrate these differences.

Literacy

Our core texts this half term are: The Gruffalo, Ruby's Worry, Love Makes a Family and Owl Babies. We will have storytime every day. We will listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity.

We will read individual letters by saying the sounds for them. We will then begin to blend sounds into words, so that we can read short words.

We will sing familiar rhymes to build a bank of songs, this will include; Hockey-Cokey, Tommy Thumb, If you're happy and you know it....

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will learn and understand how we can express our emotions.

We will discuss the need for rules and how to follow them, learning the difference between right and wrong.

To know how to be a good friend to our peers and be kind.

To talk about the special people in our lives and look at our own life journey so far and how we have changed.

We will share items and photos from home.

Maths

We will match and sort objects into different criteria (shape, colour, type of)

We will compare amounts up to 5.

Saying which group has **less that, more that, most, least** or **equal** amounts.

We will count reliably at least 6 objects saying one number name for each object.

We will compare size (**taller, shorter, the same**), mass (**heaviest, lightest, equal to**) and capacity (**full, empty half full**)

Physical Development

We will dress and undress ourselves independently for P.E

We will learn to move safely, by negotiating space and speed independently whilst exploring large and small movements.

We will use different equipment in our daily physical development lessons, such as; ribbons, pom poms, claves and many more!

The school nurse will be visiting our class on the 20th September to talk to us about being healthy

Expressive Arts and Design

We will learn how to mix powder paint using the correct sequence, water, sponge, paint, mix, to produce a desired colour.

We will learn and use painting techniques to create effects and textures to paint a collaborative owl.

We will use a variety of different constructions kits to design and create models, with a purpose in mind.

We will listen to and move to a variety of music, including music from different cultures.
